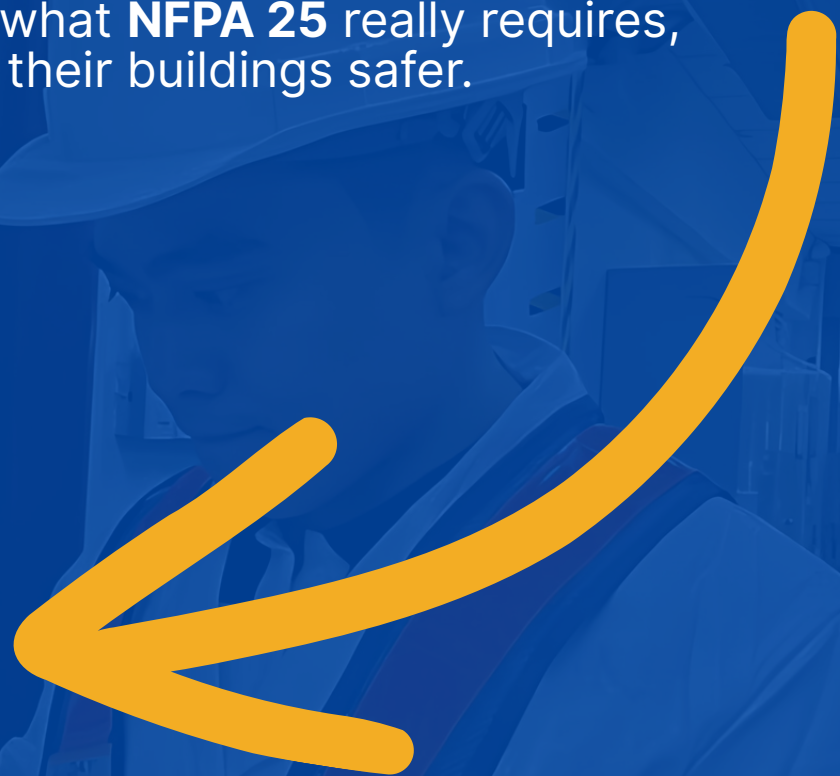
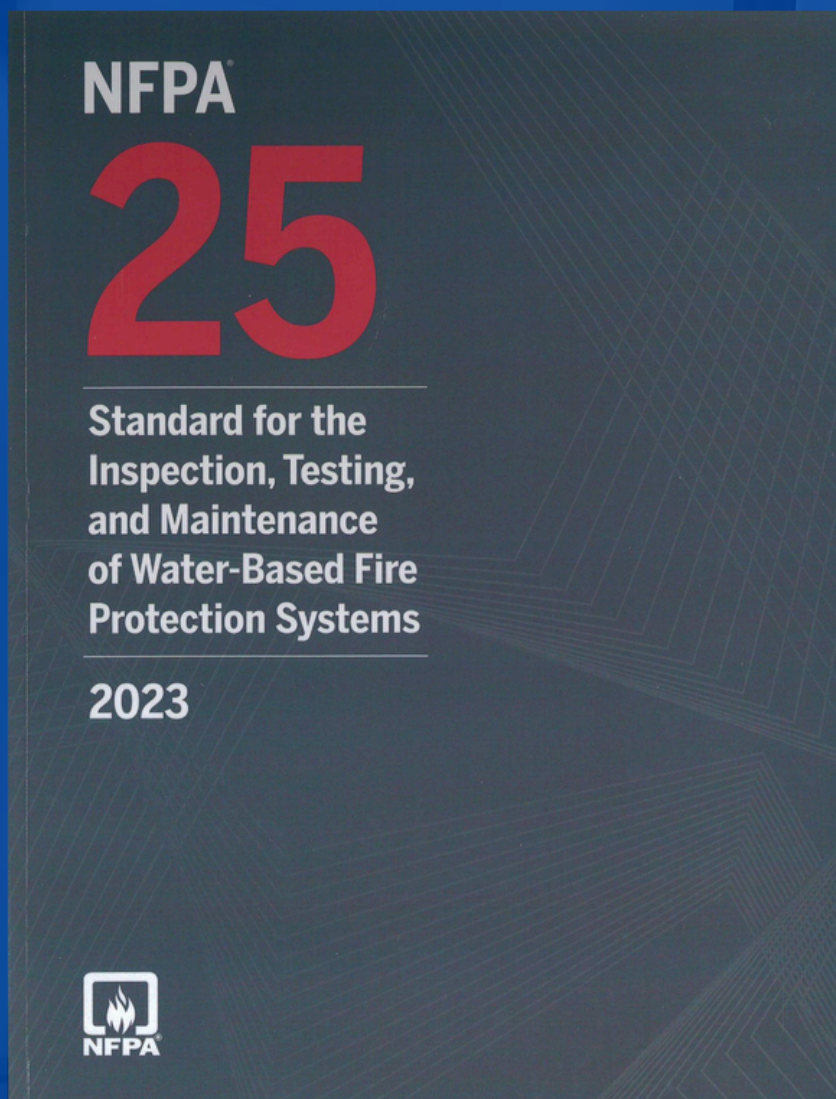

# ITM is not just maintenance.

**Inspection** means visually checking the system.

**Testing** means physically operating the system to make sure it works.

**Maintenance** means repairing or servicing components.





# Not every task requires a **contractor**.

Weekly gauge checks can often be done by **in-house staff**.

Annual fire pump tests should always be done by **certified professionals**.

Delegating wisely reduces costs while keeping your systems safe and operational.



**A common mistake** is thinking ITM is the same as a system design review.

**During ITM**, the focus is on whether your fire protection equipment is in good working condition — looking for wear, damage, or operational issues.

**Inspectors** do not evaluate if your system meets the latest design standards or building code updates.
